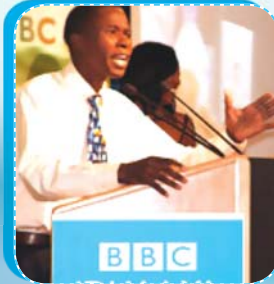
Florence Nabayinda
